

Continuous Line Drawing

Set yourself up in a peaceful and comfortable space and draw one continuous line on a sheet of drawing paper.

The rules are very simple:

- begin by drawing a continuous line.
- If you need to stop for a moment, make sure you start back up at the same spot that you stopped.
- The line should never cross another part of itself, so it is important to not get caught up in a place where you cannot get out without crossing your line.
- Control your pace! Be careful not to fill up the space too quickly, because the only thing that can stop your line is the time-limit. A never-ending line design may be completed in a 5, 10, or 20 minute time limit.
