

# Fall Landscape Reflections

Start with 12x18 drawing paper folded in half horizontally.

From the fold line up (top half of paper only), draw trees using the Y method with a brown crayon or oil pastel. Fold the paper closed and rub with a ruler to transfer the tree drawings to the bottom half as a reflection.

Using tempera paint, paint the leaves in fall colors: reds, yellows, oranges and browns. Paint the top half only! While the paint is still wet, fold to create a print on the bottom continuing the symmetry. Because the paint must be wet to create a print on the other side, you can fold and print periodically and often while painting, not having to wait until all the leaves are complete. Don't forget to add green along the fold line to create a horizon line.

Paint in the sky and water with watercolor paints. Remember: the water will be darker than the sky!

Sign and hang your work.
