

Movement Line Collage (Project Extension)

Complete a movement line design using the project steps on a 12X18 sheet of white drawing paper.

Lines should be drawn in sharpie.

Paint the spaces between the lines to emphasize the movement. Use watercolor paints and limit your color palette to tints and shades of either warm or cool colors...

Warm: reds, oranges and yellows. Cools: blues, greens, and purples.

Using the paper cutter, cut your design into 2 inch vertical strips. Rearrange the strips into a new composition and glue on a 12X18 sheet of paper.

Using the paper cutter again, cut your design into 2 inch horizontal strips (should now look like strips of squares) and glue these strips onto another 12X18 paper into a new composition.

Keep your composition balanced! Be mindful of how you arrange the new pieces.

Reflect: How did cutting up the design and rearranging the pieces affect the movement of the lines?
