

Radial Name Design

Radial Symmetry: Symmetry around a central axis.

1. Fold a square sheet of drawing paper into half in all 4 different directions (vertical, horizontal and both diagonals) to create 8 right triangles. All fold lines should converge in the center.
2. Draw your name in one of the triangles so that the tops of each letter and bottoms of each letter touch the fold lines and completely fill the triangle.
3. Trace your name with sharpie.
4. Fold on either the top fold line or bottom of your name and trace your name using a window as a light box.
5. The traced name should be an exact opposite or upside down reflection of the first name you drew.
6. Continue folding and tracing your name until it is reflected all the way around the center of your paper.

Take care to make the design flow seamlessly from one triangle to the other creating one continuous radial design.

7. Starting from the inside working out, paint your radial design



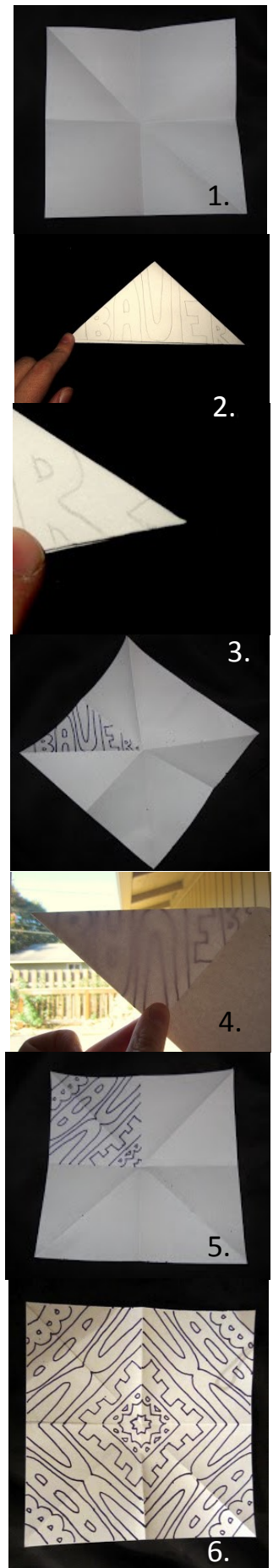
