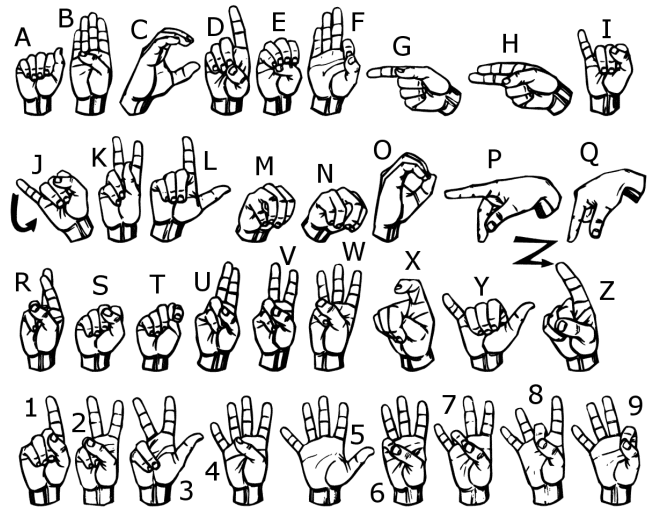


# Sign-Language Hands

To warm up your drawing skills, do 5 blind contour drawings of your non-drawing hand in 5 different (appropriate) gestures.

Project Preparation: Find the letters of your first name on the sign-language chart. Do a blind contour drawing of each of your sign-language letters of your name in your sketchbook.



Now that you have closely observed the shapes of your name in sign-language, create a composition that represents your name being spelled by your hands. You may now look at your paper. Pay close attention to details such as wrinkles, nails and knuckles.

Trace with sharpie.

Add pencil shading.

Cut out your hands and mount on a black sheet of paper.

Mount your entire composition on a white sheet cut to an appropriate size to leave a 1" border evenly around.

Sign and hang your work.
